Your thoughtful responses will provide the information our judging committee requires to assess the most deserving candidate for the *Leader in Volunteer Engagement Award*.

### **Eligibility and Nomination Criteria:**

The *Leader in Volunteer Engagement Award* is in recognition of an individual who:

- has developed and supported relevant volunteer opportunities that directly reflect and impact the mission of their organization
- worked with staff to recruit skilled volunteers throughout the organization
- acknowledges the importance and vital role that volunteers have within their organization
- developed and strengthened volunteerism throughout their organization
- was effective in their efforts in engaging volunteers
- is able to illustrate the impact of this involvement in the community
- is a current employee of an 'active' Agency Member of Volunteer MBC

Recipients of the *Leader in Volunteer Engagement Award* are selected by an independent Judging Committee and will be announced at Volunteer MBC's "The V-Oscars" Volunteer Recognition Awards Gala, being held on Thursday, April 27, 2017 in Mississauga.

**Note: Each nominee will receive one (1) free ticket to attend the event. Only one recipient will be awarded.**

### **Nomination Guidelines and Submission:**

Please read through this list below and ensure that your nomination complies with all the guidelines.

1. Nominee must meet the nomination criteria outlined for the *Leader in Volunteer Engagement Award*.
2. Nominator must obtain the consent of the nominee prior to submission.
3. By submitting the nomination form, each nominator and nominee: Consents to participating in the awards program and in the nomination process; Consents to the use of the nominee's name, photograph and nomination material in any awards related promotion or publicity carried out by Volunteer MBC.
4. Each organization may submit only one (1) nomination for the *Leader in Volunteer Engagement Award*.
5. By submitting the nomination form, each nominee agrees to participate in all awards-related activities and functions as appropriate, including the Volunteer MBC Volunteer Recognition Awards Gala, which will be held on Thursday, April 27, 2017.
6. The decisions of the Judging Committee are final.
7. Nominations and all supporting materials become the property of Volunteer MBC.
8. In accordance with the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, personal information about nominators and nominees is collected for the sole purpose of administering the Volunteer MBC Volunteer Recognition Awards Program. It will be used to select and publicize the achievements of the recipients.
9. Nominations that are incomplete or do not comply with these guidelines may be disqualified. Volunteer MBC takes no responsibility for incomplete, inaccurate, lost or late nominations.
