Volunteer MBC and Sheridan College Host 2nd Volunteer Fair

March 22, 2010 – Mississauga, ON – Volunteer MBC and Sheridan College's Student Services at the Davis Campus in Brampton are pleased to be hosting a volunteer fair on Tuesday, March 23 from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. for students, faculty, and staff, and for local community residents. It is the second volunteer fair that the volunteer centre and the Student Services have co-ordinated together and provides the opportunity for attendees to meet face-to-face with non-profit community service organizations who serve the Region of Peel. Attendees will be able to gain a better understanding of the programs and services that are available in the community and to learn more about volunteering at these organizations.

Tomorrow's volunteer fair will be held at the Sheridan College's Davis Campus at 7899 McLaughlin Road (McLaughlin Road and Steeles Avenue) and is free for anyone to attend, however, parking is extra. On campus, the fair will be located on the first and lower level of the B-wing (main entrance), and on the main floor of the H-Wing, which is the Centre for Healthy Communities the campus' newest addition.

There will be 30 community service organizations at the volunteer fair to include the Arthritis Society of Halton-Peel Region, Big Brothers Big Sisters of Peel, Breakfast for Kids, Caledon Community Services, City of Brampton Community Services, Centre for Education and Training, City of Mississauga Recreation and Parks, Junior Achievement of Central Ontario, Peel HIV/AIDS Network, Sierra Club Peel, St. John Ambulance – Mississauga Branch, and others. The fair has been made available to Volunteer MBC agency members and is one of many outreach efforts that the volunteer centre engages in across the Region of Peel.

"We are very pleased to be hosting our second volunteer fair in partnership with Sheridan College's Student Services for our agency members," stated Sharon Clark-Koufis, Marketing & Communications Manager for Volunteer MBC. "The fair will provide students with the opportunity to meet a wide variety of not-for-profit organizations that require volunteers to assist with the delivery of their programs, services and daily operations, as well as to learn more about our volunteer centre and how we are here to help."
